





## Vaccination Phased Distribution Plan

COVID-19 vaccines will be distributed through a phased approach to the most at-risk populations first. Vaccination efforts will continue until every Prince Georgian is able to get the vaccine. This is a long process that will take weeks to months to get through each phase. We will continue to keep the community updated on our progress in each phase.

#### Phase 1 Healthcare Workers. Essential Personnel & At-risk **Populations**



### Phase 1A (January-February\*)

- · Hospital and frontline healthcare workers
- · Residents and staff of long-term care facilities
- · Frontline first responders/essential public safety
- All licensed, registered and certified healthcare providers
  Department of Corrections healthcare staff and officers

#### Phase 1B (February-March\*)

- · Adults 75+
- · Assisted living and other congregate
- · Critical government leadership for continuity of operations
- · Education sector (teachers & support staff)
- · Child care workers

#### Phase 1C (March-April\*)

- · Adults 65-74 years old
- · Public safety and public health workers not covered in Phase 1A
- · Essential workers at high risk of exposure
  - 1. Grocery store workers
  - 2. Food and agriculture workers
  - 3. Postal service workers
  - 4. Public transit workers
